

Helicopter Deck Assistant

COURSE: HELICOPTER DECK ASSISTANT

SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY:

This course will cover routine helideck operations including landing, departure, handling cargo, refueling to be performed by rig personnel.

- 1. Policies and procedures when dealing with safety, communications and use of equipment;
- Preparations for helicopter landings and departures;
- Preparation and unloading/loading of freight and baggage;
- Knowledge of conditions which affect helicopter operations-weather, vessel movement;
- Potential hazardous situations during helicopter operations;
- Contribute or assist with helicopter refueling operations.

COURSE DESIGN:

Theoretical – 9 hours TOTAL: 18 hours Practical - 9 hours

PREREQUISITE(S):

None.

MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DELEGATES

This course requires a minimum of 2, and a maximum number of 12 trainees.

- Functionality of lights and accessories;
- Firefighting protective equipment ready to be operated;
- · Functional communication equipment;
- · Luggage and passengers' approach and support.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Available Helideck;
- Radio communicators;
- · Firefighting equipment.

PROCEDURE FOR PRACTICAL EXERCISES:

- · Exercises with radio communicators;
- Positioning during simulated landing and liftoff;
- Simulations of luggage and passengers approaching.

CERTIFICATION:

Certificate of Training.
