

# Banksman and Slinger Workplace Experience

COURSE: BANKSMAN AND SLINGER EXPERIENCE TASKS FOR THE LEARNER

#### SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY:

Supervised workplace experience specifies the series of supervised tasks which the learner will be required to complete to gain relevant experience in the workplace. The learner must complete a logbook record of the supervised tasks.

For the learner to become eligible to take the Banksman and Slinger Competence Assessment (stage III), a fully completed and valid Banksman and Slinger Workplace Experience Logbook (stage II) must be presented within two years from the completion date shown on the Banksman and Slinger Initial Training (stage I).

## **COURSE CONTENT / PROCEDURE FOR PRACTICAL EXERCISES:**

- 1. As a banksman, the learner must undertake the following tasks:
  - A simple pre-slung lift on three separate dates;
  - A free access lift on three separate dates:
  - c. A restricted access lift on three separate dates;
  - d. A single tubular lift on three separate dates;
  - e. A bundled tubular lift with hand signals on three separate dates;
  - f. A lift in which the load has an offset center of gravity - on three separate dates;
  - g. A lift involving a cargo carrying unit on three separate dates;
  - h. A lift consisting of bulk hose handlingon three separate dates.
  - i. A blind lift on three separate dates;
- 2. As a slinger, the learner must undertake the following tasks:

- A standard load using a single leg sling - on three separate dates
- A standard load that required more than one sling - on three separate dates
- c. A free access load on three separate dates
- d. A restricted access load- on three separate dates
- e. A single tubular load on three separate dates
- f. A bundle (3 or more) of tubulars on three separate dates
- g. A load with an offset center of gravityon three separate dates
- A lift involving a cargo carrying unit on three separate dates
- i. A load consisting of bulk hose handling - on three separate dates
- j. A blind lift on three separate dates.

#### **COURSE DESIGN:**

TOTAL: Minimum 57 days and Maximum 2 Years.

#### PREREQUISITE(S):

The Banksman and Slinger Workplace Experience Logbook will be given to the learner when they have successfully completed the Banksman and Slinger Initial Training Program.

#### MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DELEGATES

This course requires a minimum of 1 trainee.

## Banksman and Slinger Workplace Experience

#### MAIN ISSUES:

- The learner must ensure that after completing each task, they get a competent witness to sign
  and make any performance-related comments on the task sheets provided within the Logbook;
- The learner must also ensure that they get a senior employer representative to sign and complete the appropriate section of the Logbook when either;
- · The learner must complete all tasks specified in the Logbook;
- The learner must execute everything he learned in Stage I.

## REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Appropriate lifting equipment and accessories;
- Appropriate PPE (e.g., safety helmets, safety boots, eye protection, gloves, high-visibility
- vest and gloves);
- Crane;
- Slings: single leg, synthetic fiber, flat web, wire and etc.;
- Chains:
- Handsfree lifting tools (where applicable);
- Ratchet straps;
- · Radio set for banksman and crane operator;
- Tag lines.

## **CERTIFICATION:**

For the learner to become eligible to take the Banksman and Slinger Competence Assessment, a fully completed and valid Banksman and Slinger Workplace Experience Logbook within two years from the completion date shown on the Banksman and Slinger Initial Training Certificate, along with supporting evidence for each of the 19 tasks, such as a copy of the permit or toolbox talks.

### **CERTIFICATE VALIDITY PERIOD:**

2 years.
